3. HondaJet public debut in Japan: April25 to May5, 2015

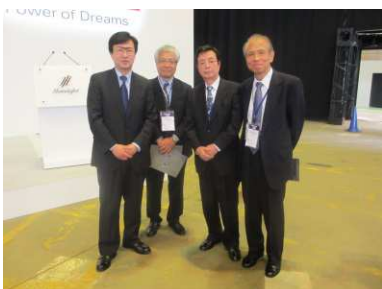
